

HOMOEOPATHIC TREATMENT

CASES OF INADEQUACY OF OTHER SYSTEMS

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It is said that in about 30 in a million persons the kidney function is irreversibly lost and that there is no remedy for such disorders save kidney transplant or frequent and repeated dialysis by an artificial kidney machine.

What has been said is relevant to the system of medication. Cases declared to be incurable by the allopaths may not necessarily be so under homoeopathic therapeutics. In many cases timely administration of homoeopathic medicines has saved many from the jaws of death. There are a large number of homoeopathic medicines which can manage even cases of high blood urea.

Inflammation of Kidneys

Inflammation of kidneys closes up the case and kills a good many in allopathic hands, but not so in Homoeopathy. Pathogenic and symptomatic conditions of the patient have to be matched with the homoeopathic drugs. Once this is achieved correctly, the medicine acts like a charm and in early stage of the disorder, the correction takes place in between 4 to 6 days.

Take another case of formation of calculi (stones) in the pelvis of the kidneys. In homoeopathic treatment, they can be dissolved without resorting to surgical methods. And in the process, the system is so corrected that it is fortified against recurrence of the trouble. The surgery in allopathy has made tremendous progress but equally weak is the remedial aspect of the allopathic system and the number of curative medicine is awfully inadequate. Moreover, the antibiotics are so much in use these days. Homoeopathic researches have shown that they could damage organs like kidneys, liver, spleen, vision, etc., and disturb the functions of various other organs. In this connection, the above statement

about the inadequacy of curative medicines should be examined.

Enlarged Tonsils

Now take a simple case of enlarged Tonsils, and on its removal by operation, any benefit accruing therefrom is at once enjoyed by the sufferer. But is the thing really over? I fear it is not. The tonsils are nature's secured outpost of respiratory tract and as such are constantly at work to do outpost duty of warning signal of the disease inside. When the warning outpost is destroyed, there is no warning device to indicate the worsening situation inside of the man, which may ultimately take a more destructive virulence.

In the medical treatment of the enlarged tonsils the procedure to be

adopted is to cure the cause of the enlargement. If this is done the enlargement will permanently disappear. This is the best way to treat this ailment. The perfect cure is where the enlargement disappears under the influence of the dynamic remedies. Here the normal tonsils remain to do the work allotted to them within the nature's cycle.

Causative Relation

The compartmental method of treatment incapacitates the traditional system of medicine to discover the causative relation between ailments having a common cause. In this respect, the homoeopaths enjoy a distinct advantage over the traditional method of treatment. The homoeopaths treat the human being as a whole rather than in parts.
